



General Description and Key Features

- New corridor north of the existing roadway, from approximately MP 46.5 to 55.5, west of Sportsman's Landing
- 825-foot to 1,200-foot bridge crossing Juneau Creek Canyon, approximately 2,000 feet south of Juneau Creek Falls (two bridge options)

Estimated Construction and Project Costs

- New construction estimate, including highway, right-of-way, and private property acquisition: \$126.5 million

Key Impact Concerns Associated with the Alternative

- Impacts to historic/archeological sites
- Wetland and vegetated habitat impacts
- Resurrection Pass Trail crossing
- KNWR Wilderness boundary crossing
- KPB land selection

Effects on Traffic

- 70% of traffic is expected to use new alignment, with 30% using the existing corridor.
- Improves level of service from existing highway conditions.
